You will need.....


Newspaper Googly eyes Coloured card or wool Glitter if you have some Texter.

- 1. Ask an adult to help you cut out the shapes of the witches face and hat.
- 2. Stick your newspaper face on to card or a large piece of paper.
- 3. Stick on your googly eyes and give your witch some hair.
- 4. Last of all put on the witches hat which can be made from black card or painted newspaper.
- 5. You could make the witch into a Mask instead of using googly eyes cut out eye holes to see out of. Then make holes on the side of the face and attach some elastic.

• Find a suitable tub.

- Fill the tub with cool water.
- Float several apples in the water.
- Select the order of players.

- Keep track of how long it takes each player to get their apple. You can give a time limit per player, to keep things moving at a fun pace.
- Select the winner, whoever got their apple the quickest!
