## ARTWORK CATEGORIES

**Framed Works - ready to hang.** Includes framed paintings, ready to hang canvases, sculptures and ornaments.

**Unframed Works - not ready to hang.** Includes sketches, original prints and artwork. These items are required to be presented in a clear protective casing.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### Framed Artwork - ready to hang

1. An exhibitor may enter a maximum of 4 items (paintings and /or 3D items).
2. Each painting must be suitably framed or be ready for hanging and be the original work of the artist.
3. The work should be clearly marked on the back with the title, artist name, address & price.
4. Items should be limited in size to 1m x 1m.
5. The committee reserves the right to not display any item.

### Unframed Works - not ready to hang

1. An artwork exhibitor may enter a maximum of 10 unframed works.
2. Each work must be presented in a clear protective sleeve with a mounting/backing board.
3. Works are not to exceed A3 size - including any mountings.
4. The Art Show Committee reserves the right to refuse an entry if it does not comply with size limitation.
5. Works should be clearly marked on the back with the title, artist name, & price.

### Mixed Media

1. Please contact us for more information regarding presentation requirements for your artwork.

## GENERAL

1. All items must be for sale.
2. Commission of 25% will be deducted from ALL sales.
3. All reasonable care of items will be taken, however Roberts McCubbin Primary School will not be responsible for damages or loss.
4. All fees are to be submitted with the Entry form.
5. Artists submitting Unframed Works only will still incur a one-off fee payment of \$10.
6. Entry forms to be completed and returned to Roberts McCubbin Primary School by **closing date - Wednesday 2nd March 2022**
7. The winner of the 'Best in Show' is to provide a piece of artwork for the next Roberts McCubbin Art Show.
8. Any changes to entry details must be made prior to catalogue printing - **Wednesday 17th March 2021**
9. The committee reserves the right to not display any item.
